



Don't Limit Yourself

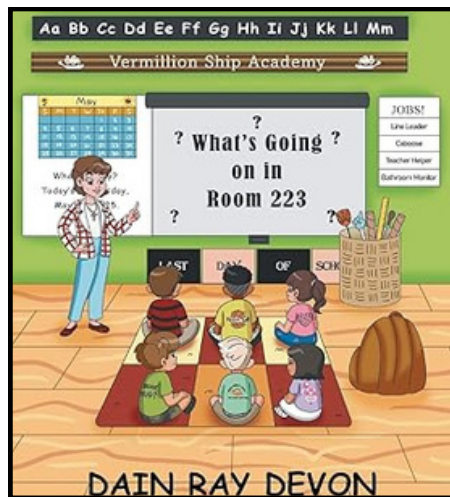
